

**RESOLUTION 17-29**

*A resolution rescinding Resolution 17-22 that implemented a county-wide burn ban.*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commission may declare a state of local disaster emergency upon a finding that a disaster has occurred or the threat thereof is imminent within such County.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Resolution 17-22 implemented a county-wide burn ban that was effective until further action of the Board of County Commissioners due to the extreme weather and drought conditions and threat of disaster in the event of a fire.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the conditions that led to the issuance of Resolution 17-22 have lessened and that the resolution should be rescinded.

**THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHEYENNE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, That resolution 17-22 adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on November 30, 2017, is hereby rescinded.
