

RESOLUTION NO. 16-15

A resolution expressing the property taxation policy of the Cheyenne County Commission with respect to financing the annual budget for 2017

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, provides that a levy of property taxes to finance the 2017 budgets of Cheyenne County and Fire District No. 1 exceeding the amount levied to finance the 2016 budgets as adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for calendar year 2015, be authorized by a resolution adopted in advance of the adoption of a budget supported by such levy; and

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, also provides that current year revenue that is produced and attributable to the taxation of (1) new improvements, (2) increased personal property valuation, and (3) property which has changed in use shall not be considered when determining whether revenue produced from property tax has increased from the preceding year; and

Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all county services are the responsibility of the board of commissioners; and


Whereas, Cheyenne County and Fire District No. 1 provides essential services to its citizens; and


Whereas, the cost of providing these services continues to increase.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cheyenne County Commission that a levy of property taxes in support of the 2017 budgets exceeding the amount levied in 2016, as adjusted pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, is hereby approved.


