MULTI YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS duly assembled in regular session this 30th day of November, 2016 and by the authority vested in said board of County Commissioners do hereby resolve according to the authority given the Board of County Commissioners in K.S.A. 19-120:


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer of Cheyenne County, State of Kansas, shall be authorized and directed to create a fund for the County of Cheyenne in the State of Kansas that is to be named the MULTI YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND. The County Treasurer shall transfer remaining budget authority, per audit, for the purpose of financial support of the MULTI YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND into said fund; and, shall upon authorization of the Cheyenne County Commissioners may pay out any expenses for the MULTI YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

Per K.S.A. 19-120b: Moneys in such capital improvements fund may be used to finance, in whole or in part, any public improvement need set forth in the adopted capital improvement plan, including the repair, restoration and rehabilitation of existing public facilities. The resolution may provide that disbursements from such fund may be made for engineering and other advance public improvement plans and studies and that reimbursements may be made to the fund from bond proceeds, special assessment or state or federal aid available for the completed project.
