Convene

Chairman Brett Poling called the meeting of the Cheyenne County Board of Commission to order at 1:00 P.M. on June 28, 2016 at the Board Room. Attendance: Brett Poling, Present: John Garner, Present: Rodney Radcliffe, Present. Also present was County Clerk, Deb Lindsten. The purpose of the special meeting was for the BOCC to meet with Department Heads to discuss their proposed budgets for next year. Chairman Poling led the meeting in the pledge of allegiance.

General Discussion

Discussion was held with Elected Officials and Department Heads regarding their budget requests for 2017. Those presenting budget requests were Grant Administrator/Public Transportation, Carol Sloper; EM Director, Ryan Murray; EMS Director, Reid Raile; County Treasurer, Dolores Jenik; Register of Deeds, Jeanne Dunn; Building and Grounds Supervisor, Shelley Christensen; Dispatch Director, Eric Harper; County Clerk, Deb Lindsten; District Court Clerk, Natalie Stahlecker; and Fire Chief, Dan Blair. Department Heads shared with the BOCC that it was very difficult to budget the personnel line item. They encouraged the BOCC to make personnel decisions to ensure more accurate budget requests. Budgets were presented with no decisions being made.
